

**RESOLUTION 23-18
OF THE HELIX WATER DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS
DECLARING AN END TO WATER SHORTAGE RESPONSE LEVEL 2**

WHEREAS on March 28, 2022, Governor Gavin Newsom issued Executive Order N-7-22 ordering the State Water Resources Control Board to consider adopting emergency regulations; and

WHEREAS the State Water Resources Control Board then adopted a statewide emergency water conservation regulation requiring urban water suppliers to implement all demand-reduction actions under Level 2 of their water shortage contingency plans; and

WHEREAS on November 2, 2022, the Helix Water District Board of Directors adopted Resolution 22-60 implementing the district's water shortage response Level 2 reduction measures; and

WHEREAS on March 24, 2023, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-5-23 easing drought restrictions in response to recent storms bringing historic rain and snow to California; and

WHEREAS per the Helix Water District Policies and Procedures Manual 2023 Section 4.9-13(D), the district's board of directors may declare an end to water shortage response Level 2 by adoption of a resolution at any regular or special board meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Helix Water District Board of Directors as follows:


1. The district finds and determines that the above recitals are true and correct.
2. The board declares an end to the water shortage response Level 2 effective immediately upon adoption of Resolution 23-18.
3. This resolution shall supersede any and all conflicting resolutions and policies and procedures.
